This logo tells the story of Our Ways Strong Together and our approach to constructing an impactful, holistic approach to addressing Family, Domestic and Sexual Violence within our Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander communities.



Community Circle: At the centre of the logo is a Community Circle, where community, stakeholders, and service providers are invited to be a part of impact and change.



Connection to Country: This is embedded throughout the workings of Our Ways Strong Together. It signifies how vital it is to support each other on this journey, and the importance of cultural lore and governance being intertwined throughout processes.



Support: The outer layer represents a safety net of support, not only for community but also for service providers and the ripple effect of this peak body to the wider community.



Journey Lines: Represent the different paths people take, not only on their healing journeys but also their connections to service providers. These lines are organic to show that our journeys are not linear and each person's path looks different.

Lauren is a proud Wodi Wodi and Walbunja person and artist from the Yuin Nation.




Our Cultural Elements

Safety & Healing



This element represents the need to rely on truth telling to create impactful and beneficial change for the future to keep Families safe while on their healing journey.

Collaboration

Self Determination

This element represents self determination being at the forefront of the functionality of Our Ways Strong Together, focusing on community leadership and cultural knowledge.



Equity & Inclusion

This element represents Our Ways Strong Together's deep commitment to equity and inclusion, ensuring our work delivers meaningful benefits for all Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people and communities impacted by Family, Domestic and Sexual Violence.
